## Earn up to 60 hours of nursing continuing education and complete a certificate in Community Health Ministry

The Meros Center offers a fully online professional development training program with the theory and skills to conduct faith-based community assessments and design a community health ministry strategy for your organization, church, or neighborhood.

Through a participatory learning approach, you will discover and master gospel-centered health strategies. You'll broaden your understanding of cultures and sharpen your ability to engage with communities while addressing serious health concerns.

*Cost: \$495 for full certificate or \$99 for each self-study course*

To earn nursing contact hours, participants must successfully complete all assessment activities. Partial credit can be given for individual learning modules when an assessment has been completed successfully.
